He is also the Wessex regional lead for cancers in Teenagers and Young Adults (TYA) and Clinical Lead for the Thames Valley and Wessex TYA Operational Delivery Network.

Prof. Davies specialises in the treatment of malignant lymphoma. His work also focuses on translation of biomarkers and novel therapies to the clinical arena. He has extensive experience in early phase trials, including leading several first in man lymphoma studies all the way through to leading late phase studies.
